Issues and challenges in K-12 schools



Violence in school

Public schools continue to face challenges related to safety and student behavior. These incidents disrupt learning and highlight the growing need for proactive security measures, behavioral interventions, and stronger support systems for students and staff.



Smoking and vaping

E-cigarette use is a challenge in schools, impacting student health and disrupting learning. Schools are enforcing stricter policies and using vape detectors to address the issue. This trend has led schools to implement more stringent bathroom policies and install vape detectors to combat in-school vaping.



School bus safety

During the 2023-2024 school year, a survey found that 98,065 school bus drivers reported 66,322 vehicles illegally passing their buses in a single day—underscoring the persistent risks to student safety. In 2021-2022, approximately 19% of students aged 12-18 reported being bullied at school, with incidents more likely to occur in areas with less adult supervision, such as on school buses. Addressing these concerns requires comprehensive safety measures, including enhanced driver training, stricter enforcement of traffic laws, and the adoption of advanced safety technologies on school buses.



Bullying

Bullying remains a widespread issue in schools. According to a 2023 UNESCO report, more than 30% of students worldwide have experienced bullying, leading to both immediate and long-term effects—including lower academic achievement, increased dropout rates, and negative impacts on physical and mental health.



Cybersecurity concerns

As schools integrate more technology into their curriculum, they face a growing risk of cyberattacks. In 2024, the education sector became the most targeted industry, with organizations experiencing an average of 3,086 attacks per week, a 37% increase from 2023.


