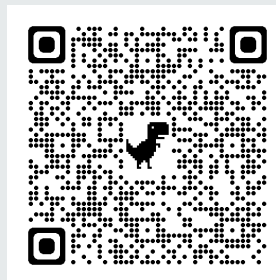

- Paid tuition scholarship
 - housing and textbook stipend
- Paid 10-week summer internship program (Summer 2025)
 - includes housing and transportation to Chicago
- Paid employment
- Leadership empowerment education
- Leadership/workplace enablement
- Opportunity for full-time employment upon completion of the fellowship

Candidate Criteria

- Must be enrolled full-time at a participating HBCU for the coming academic terms as a rising senior
- Have an expected graduation date of May 2026
- Must maintain a 3.0 GPA
- Campus or community involvement
- Desire to lead in a corporate environment
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Must be able to participate in and successfully complete all program-related activities
- Serve as CDW Legacy Excellence Program Ambassador during tenure in the program

Scholarship
